**BLACK** - Sin Romans 3:23 | All have sinned

**RED** - Blood I John 1:7 | Jesus' blood covers all sin

**WHITE** - Pure Psalm 51:7 | Jesus washes away confessed sin

**YELLOW** - Heaven John 14:2 | Believe on Jesus and receive Eternal Life

**GREEN** - Grow 2 Peter 3:18 | Grow in the knowledge of the Lord
